

# Tech Note 27: InDesign Page Exporter Utility

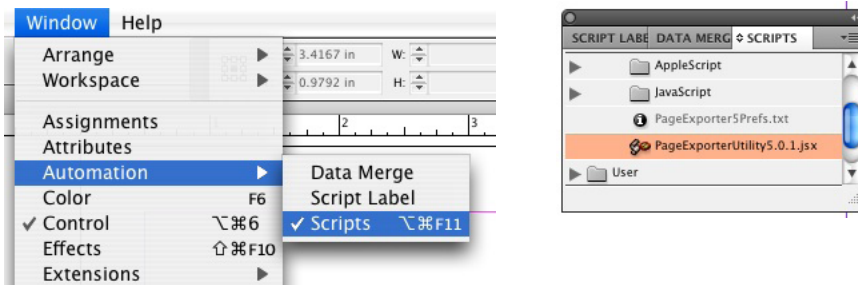

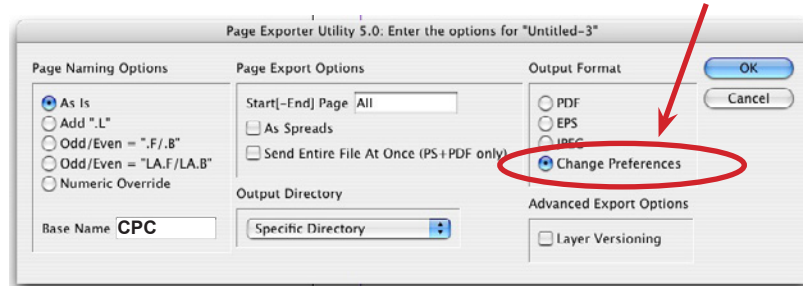

Unzip the download and follow the installation instruction in the manual.

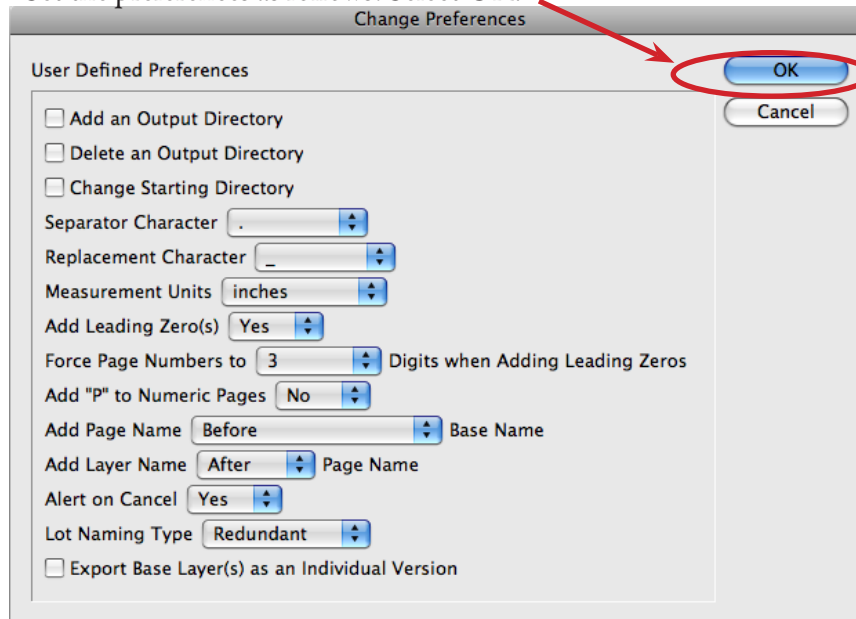
To use the utility go to Automation/Scripts. Double click the script.



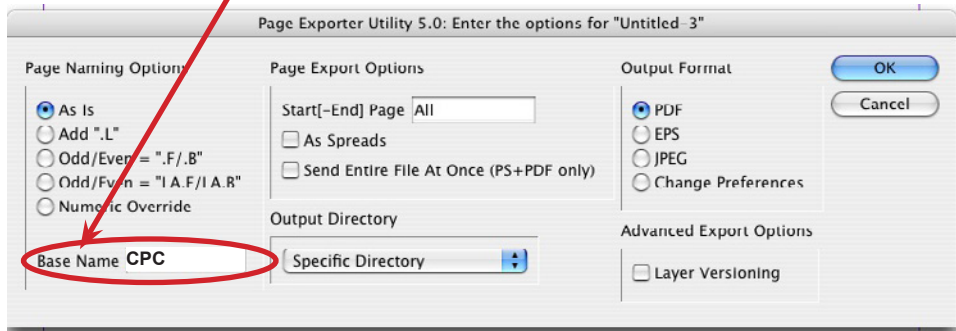
The first time you use it you will have to set the preferences. Select the change preferences and select OK.



Set the preferences as follows: Select OK.

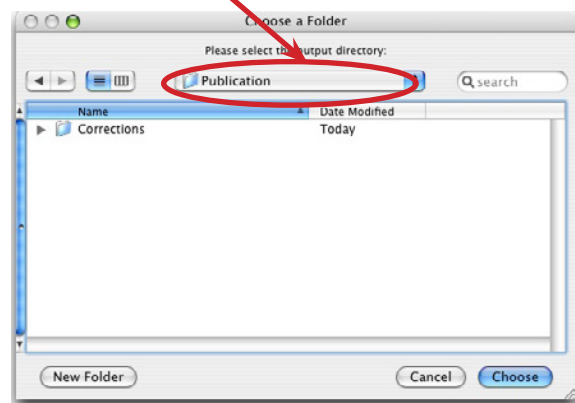
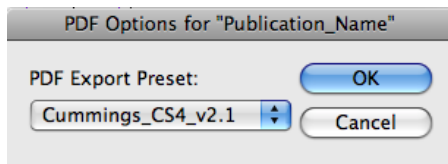


In the base name field enter your pub code and select OK.

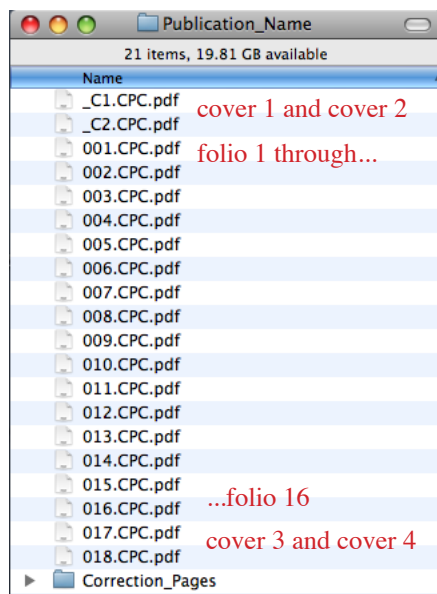


Select your file location.

Select your PDF settings.



The example below represents a publication that begins with folio 1 as the first text page. The covers in this example were manually renamed after export and then added to the directory. Covers 3 and 4 are numbered as the last two text pages, regardless of whether they contain a folio or not.



The screen shot at right represents a simple 16 page publication with the first folio beginning with 1.
